



Facial Dermal Fillers

Ageing is a natural process where the body changes over time with the passing of the years. One of the effects of ageing is the depletion of collagen, which keeps the skin elastic, supple and plumped up. When collagen starts to get depleted, wrinkles and fine lines will form. In older people, there might be sagging skin and sunken areas visible too.

However, with improvements in aesthetics, people now have many options to help them maintain their natural look of youthfulness.

Facial Remodelling

Dermal fillers include nose fillers, chin fillers and under eye fillers. Frequently used for facial remodelling, the face can be reshaped to make your features sharper or smoother. The procedure is quick and relatively painless, with minimal downtime.

When fillers are injected into the under eye area near the lower lashline, it has a dual role. Firstly, it accentuates the eyes, making them look bigger and rounder. This gives a more youthful and sweeter appearance. Secondly, it draws attention away from the dark circles under the eyes due to lack of sleep. This treatment is known as the famous Korean 'love band' plumper, also known as the Ageyo Sal

plumper. It is a favourite under eye filler which helps improve the appearance of eye bags or dark eye circles.

Lip fillers are administered to restore the volume and natural contours of the lips, reproducing the ideal lip shape which you had in your youth. Most people associate full and attractive lips with youth, beauty and sensuality. The lip fillers will also address the fine lines typical on dehydrated lips.

Nose and chin fillers help to add volume in the right places. People born with less definition or lose definition over time from the natural process of aging can use fillers to create a more defined nose, strong jawline, more desired angularity and chin projection to overcome any chin recession or look of a weak chin.

Benefits of Dermal Face Fillers

This minimally-invasive treatment helps to improve skin texture and reduce the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles. The procedure also helps to replace lost facial volume.

The use of chin and nose fillers produce more defined contours. This gives an immediate effect and can help solve any issues you have with the way you look.

For younger people, this treatment can help to prevent the formation of wrinkles, and add volume where necessary, in areas such as the nose bridge, chin, forehead, cheeks and lips. It is also useful to correct recessed scars.

The treatment effects will last from 12 to 18 months.

Treatment Areas

The areas that can be treated with dermal fillers include the forehead, frown lines, brows, under eye area, tear troughs, temple, crow's feet, nose, cheeks, jaw, lips, lip wrinkles, nasolabial folds, marionette lines, and the chin.

This minimally-invasive procedure is done via injections into the skin using a small needle. The effects will vary from patient to patient. Some patients may experience slight bruising. However, this is usually mild and will disappear after a few days. It can be easily be concealed with makeup.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. How long does fillers last?

Fillers last about 12 to 18 months.

2. How long do I have to wait to see the results?

Results are immediate. There may be some slight swelling but it will go away in a day or two.

3. Is the procedure painful?

A numbing cream will be applied prior to the fillers injection and most patients will find it bearable.

4. Is there any downtime?

There may be some swelling but no downtime. Most of our patients treat it as a lunch time procedure.

5. Is the procedure safe?

Yes, it is important that you consult an experience medical doctor who uses only approved FDA-products.
